What's included in the scholarship?

- Attendance to 2 & 1/2 day Summit
- Meals through out the Summit including dinner
- Accommodation Wednesday 10th, Thursday 11th June for rural and regional delegates, if required.

Confirmation

Your place has been confirmed when Confirmation of Registration and scholarship is sent to you.

Information about the venue, transport options and any program updates will be included in the Confirmation of Registration.

Eligibility

People applying for the scholarship must :

- Be an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person residing in NSW
- Demonstrate their interest in attending the Summit
- Demonstrate how they will use the information gained at the Summit when they return to their community.
- Be over 18 years old

Roles and Responsibilities

Delegates Responsibilities

- cover any costs incurred during their stay at accommodation, including room service, minibar, telephone calls, internet usage, and/or in-house movies or damages
- cover meals outside the conference (minus breakfast with accommodation)
- responsible for reading and understanding roles and responsibilities, what costs are included and to what amount

AH&MRC Responsibilities

- morning/afternoon teas and lunch provided to delegates on all days of the Summit
- booking of accommodation for all delegates (all non-smoking rooms) if indicated on registration form
- cover the cost of accommodation (including breakfast)
- confirm registration and scholarship to Summit to individuals in writing no later than 14 days for travel arrangements to be made for individuals to attend

Cancellation Policy

- We kindly ask that all cancellations are made in writing to Kim Merritt, by **Monday 25th May 2015**, so we can offer the place to others.
- Failure to notify the AH&MRC of any attendance cancellations, may result in AH&MRC seeking reimbursement for booked travel.
